Intro: Encourage deeper dives, conversations, reading of Acts and Luke. The immensity of the topic of the person of the Holy Spirit. Sit quietly in God's presence with His Word, and by His Spirit be quickened with revelation and insight.

Observations from Luke's good news story:

Jesus was **Born** by the Spirit

- Luke 1:35
- Father's day – we long for this birth in our children; some among us are Fathers to others in this room
- So must we be (John 1:12; John 3:5 – 8)

Jesus was **marked out** as special by the Spirit at his baptism (Luke 3:21)

- Identity
- So are we. Same Spirit calls out and confirms our Identity (Family, Beloved, Pleasing)
- We've got a Dad! All of us who are born into Christ by His Spirit (Gal 4:4)

Jesus was **filled** by The Spirit and nearly ready to be launched (Luke 4:1)

- Trusted
- Tested
- Sustained
- Dad's do this development. Dad's get their children ready.
- So are we / So will be

Jesus **launches ministry** in power of the Holy Spirit (Luke 4:14)

- The declarations and purpose are now made public (Luke 4:18)
- Good news
- Poor, captives, blind, oppressed
- Liberty – Freedom has a leader
- So should we: Recovery, Single Moms, Downtown Bloomington, Marriages, Young people, Mentoring, Universities, students

Jesus **celebrates growing disciples** in the joy of the Holy Spirit (Luke 10:21)

- Remember "Watch me"?
- So should we (get those pickle jars before the stores run out!)
  - Harvest and pray
  - Heal the sick in it and say to them, "The kingdom of God has come near to you."
  - Authority
  - Right rejoicing
