FOR OLDER KIDS: Scripture Scavenger Hunt Materials: Bible, cards with Bible verse references

<u>Preparation:</u> Before you begin, write the following Bible verse references on separate slips of paper:

- Psalm 139:23-24
- Psalm 51:10
- Psalm 19:14
- Ezekiel 11:19
- 1 Chronicles 29:17-18

Hide each card in a separate room of your house. (Just be sure to remember where you hid them!)

When you begin the activity, ask your family members to list some things you do around the house to get ready for the holidays. Then explain that you are all going on a hunt to find some Bible verses. These verses will tell us what we need to do to get our hearts ready!

Reveal the room where the hunt should begin and bring your Bible along with you. When you find the first card, look up and read that verse. Continue until you have found all the verses!
