


GOD HAS A PLAN:

Now, Jacob sends Joseph out to check on his brothers. I wonder if Joseph's brothers thought he was a tattletale.



Have you ever had to go through something that was hard? Something that was unpleasant? We all have difficult stuff in our lives but we can trust God to always be with us and help us through it.


Day 3

Day 5
