

Here are a few suggestions about how to use this activity for your family:

- Enjoy & review the coloring sheet that the kids brought home from this Sunday's story—check out the announcements, too!
- Read the new story first during your quiet time. Ask God to show you how to share it with your child appropriately.
- Choose a good or regular time each week to present" the story you will hear in Sunday School this Sunday!"
- Find the story in a children's bible or tell it in your own words, emphasizing the big idea.
- Repeat the verse and big idea often during the week, looking for ways to apply it.

All About Growing Your Child Spiritually:

Deuteronomy 6:1-9 is a message to parents! It basically says that your child will grow spiritually the way you are growing spiritually. In other words, your child will grow to be like YOU! When you pray, your child notices. She will learn that turning to God in all things is the best way to live life. When you read your Bible, your child will learn that knowing God is important and they will want to read their Bible.

I know it doesn't always feel like it, but the time you have with your child goes faster than you think. There's an app I recommend called "Legacy Countdown". It will calculate the # of weeks you have left with your child until he leaves home and heads off for college. It's a good reminder to make every moment count.
